The Budapest Christian Library is a nonprofit, private lending library located on the banks of the Danube River in central Budapest, Hungary. It was established in 2003 under the auspices of the Institute for Christian Resource and through the amazing efforts of one retired husband and wife team, Phyllis and Harold Anderson. It was founded on the belief that good books are essential partners with personal evangelism in enabling people to know the peace

of Christ. Funding for both library resources and operational expenses is entirely through the donations of Christians in the United States, Hungary, and other countries. The library provides about 8000 volumes of books and other resources as well as serving as a meeting place for Christians and those seeking to know more about Christ.
