Northwest Haiti Christian Mission

Northwest Haiti Christian Mission began with church and orphanage, which started in Port de Paix in 1979. Many people had died during a seven-year drought, leaving children with no one to care for them. In 2007, the mission board found a piece of land in the Far West with several acres that could be used for the orphanage. The orphanage is now located in a place called Salines Myet, which is close to the town of Beauchamp. The orphanage currently helps provide clothing, education, food, health services, love and spiritual nurture to approximately one hundred children. They have moved them from the big city to the country, with full confidence that it was the best place to raise children

The orphanage is divided into nine homes grouped into three separate clusters – one for girls, one for boys, and one for the bitty ones ages 1 to 5. The older children are further divided into homes within their clusters, according to age.

The mission has hired a well-known pastor in the area, Pastor Edner Luc, to run the new orphanage. Pastor Luc is meeting with the children weekly, teaching them to memorize scripture, and guiding them through the Bible. Madam Robert is the “mother” of the children under 5. She and her husband, Robert, are the “parents” that BCC supports on a monthly basis. The greatest hope for these kids is for them to know Christ, to trust Him, and to believe that he is great enough to overcome every destructive influence in their lives. The hope is to raise them with knowledge and self-assurance, with skills that they can use to make Haiti a better place

Most Haitians live very simple lives. They are hard workers and often rise before the sun to accomplish the tasks of the day. This new campus does not carry the modern amenities that the other one was known for. The generator only runs for three hours in the evening. The children will have great opportunities to deepen their character as they tend to the orphanage garden and to animals there. The kids raise chickens and sell the eggs in the marketplace. They are learning to cook, clean, wash their clothes (by hand) and even bucket in their own water.

Train up a child in the way he should go and when he is old he will not depart from it.
